Exhibit Eligibility

DAEA member visual art teachers who are currently practicing artists are invited to participate in this juried exhibit. To be considered, teachers must have completed a course in an Art summer workshop offered by Miami-Dade County Public Schools' Art Department in the past or will be attending this summer.

All artists must submit a portfolio of three to-ten recent artworks to have one or more pieces juried into the show. There are no size or media restrictions. The series must be thematically unified, or a cohesive body of work showing your strongest work.

***Submitting a portfolio does not guarantee that your work will be accepted into the show. However, each artist will receive a written critique by the judges who are professionals in the field if they request one.

Jury & Selection Process: The exhibit will be juried by Yvonne Ferrer, artist/curator and Odette Lopez, Director of Museum of Contemporary Art of the Americas,

Digital Submission

Visual artists must upload images, [artist statement](#), bio, and completed entry form to the Authentic Assessment Portal under Artistic License

Image Requirements

- 2 d works-Include 1 images of each artwork. 2 images of 3D works from different angles. Do not use camera phones. Please use a professional camera and good lighting.
- Save images as jpeg format.
- Save the image to coincide with the entry number on application, EX: 1PollackJackson, 1961, Paint on canvas, 100 x 300 in. \$10,000,000
- For Video entries send a link to president@dadearteducators.org but complete application on the Authentic Assessment.
- Our department reserves the right to use all the information in applications, including images for publicity purposes.

Artist Statement & Resume

All applicants must upload on Authentic Assessment a resume, artist statement, and a short bio about this particular body of work no longer than three paragraphs. The artist statement, bio and resume must be included with the digital entries and also be sent with the accepted artwork as a hard copy.

PICK-UP: All work must be picked up in a timely manner after the closing of the show. Any work not picked up by the end of this period may be subject to a storage fee.
